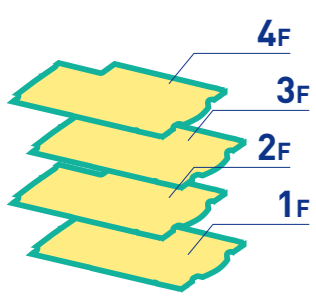

2F We offer only one time for each program per person. In addition, please refrain from eating and drinking inside the building (except the space around vending machines). Thank you for your understanding.

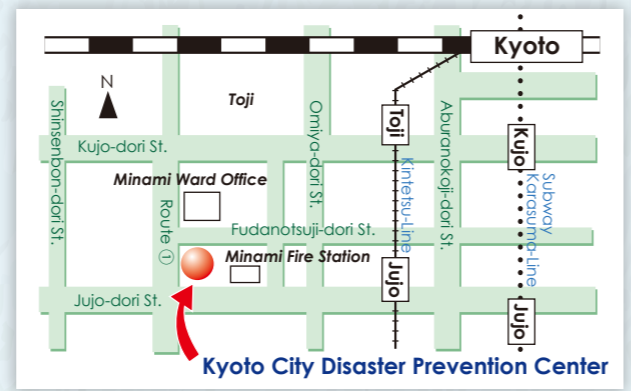

How to use our hands-on facilities
(Experience Programs)

Details regarding the experience programs including the schedule of availability of our hands-on facilities are posted on the website. Please check the details on the different programs in advance and gather in front of each venue by the time indicated. Participants will be accepted on a first-come, first-served basis until the maximum number of people per facility has been reached. Groups of ten or more people will be given a tour of the various facilities after an introductory briefing.

In order to create a community-wide local disaster preparedness framework, the program will provide simulated experiences at our hands-on facilities for members of disaster management associations and other organizations to enhance their knowledge of disaster prevention and confirm the importance of preparedness in the event of a disaster.

- **Opening hours** 9am - 5pm
 - **Closed days** Mondays (National holidays, January 17th and September 1st except. In the case that a national holidays, closure will be postponed to the following weekday. If that day falls on the second Tuesday of the month, the following weekday.)
Second Tuesday of each month (Public holidays except)
New Year's holiday (December 28th to January 4th)
 - **Admission** free
 - **Reservation** Groups of more than 10 persons can make a reservation 3 months before their admission day.
 * In case of Kyoto citizens group reservation may be made even 4 months in advance.

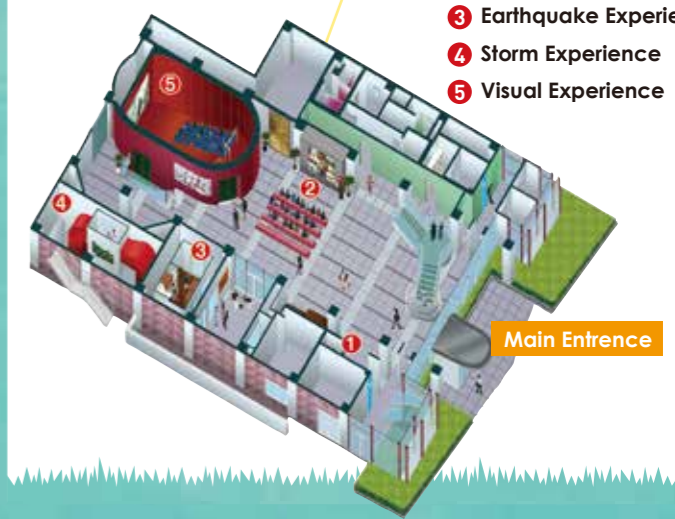

1F Visual Experience

Experience several disasters that struck Kyoto in the past through our high definition (HD) cinema. (20 min)



1F Storm Experience

Fighting against wind as fast as 32m/sec makes any action difficult - as you will learn in this room. (20min)



1F Earthquake Experience

Earthquakes in the scale of 4 to 7 in magnitude make not only yourself but also your interior shake! (20min)



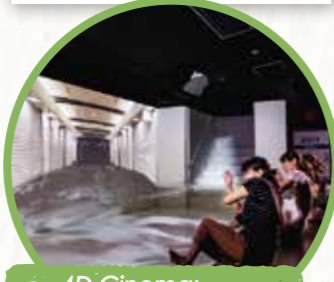
2F Evacuation Procedure Experience

Here you can experience a realistic fire accident setting in an hotel so you can practice how to effectively escape through smoke. (20min)



2F Fire Extinguishing Experience

In this session, participants will learn how to handle a fire extinguisher and experience extinguishing a simulated fire on a monitor. (20min)
(Participation only possible over the age of 9.)



3F 4D Cinema: The Narrowing Basement

Experience disasters caused by water and how to handle them in this 4D cinema simulating a flooded basement. (20min)



3F Hydrostatic Door Experience (in 4D theater)

Participants will experience how difficult it is to open a door when water pressure is applied to it in the event of flooding.



3F Landslide Disaster Experience

Learn about the dangers and mechanisms that cause landslide disasters. Powerful images at our "Real Theater" will leave a strong impression on you for sure. (20min)

Training facilities — Workplace training, etc.



2F Training Room Disaster Prevention Center

In order to improve the knowledge of disaster prevention and how to actually handle with disasters we provide a training program containing how to operate automatic disaster alarm systems and much more.



2F-3F Training Room Simulated building

Comprehensive training on a series of safety procedures in the event of fire in a simulated building that can be set up in various ways, such as a store retailer, a hotel, or an apartment building.



Daily Life Safety Corner

Hands-on practice and training in the use of AED and first aid using training dummies.

3F Firefighting helicopter



The helicopter on display was the second helicopter use by the Kyoto City Fire Department. The helicopter was acquired in the wake of the growing demand for aerial firefighting services. It performed rescue operations, collected information on disaster sites, and was used as a firefighting helicopter for 17 years until 2005, when it was replaced by the new "Hiei-go" helicopter.

Put out all little flames setting your home on fire!



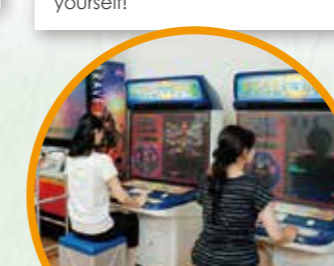
3F Simulator "Air Rescue Pilot"

This is a firefighting simulation game that recreates a real fire with "flames" and "water" using 3D and CG technology. Can you rescue the people and extinguish the fire?



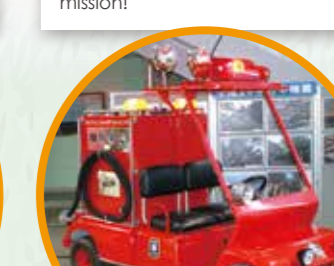
3F Disaster Prevention Learning Mini Game
